<p>Department of Zoological Sciences</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • B.Ed (Science) Main, Mombasa & Kitui • Bachelor of Science Main, Mombasa & Kitui • BSc Biology - Main • BSc Coastal & Marine - Main 	<p>A student wishing to pursue course in Zoological Sciences must satisfy the minimum University requirements and the regulations of the school or faculty to which the student is joining. A student must have passed Mathematics in the K.C.S.E. at a minimum grade of C+. In addition students must have passed Biology or Biological Sciences in K.C.S.E. with a minimum of grade B- and any other two subjects from the following alternatives at the minimum grades shown:</p> <p>Alternative A: Chemistry C+, Biology B-, Physics C+, Geography B-.</p> <p>Alternative B: Physical Sciences B-, Biological Sciences B-, Geography B-.</p> <p>Or: 1.1. Have a minimum of 2 principal passes in science subjects in Kenya Advanced Certificate of Education (KACE or A-level), one of which must be Biology</p> <p>Or: 1.2. Have a diploma in relevant subjects with at least a credit pass from an institution recognized by the University Senate,</p> <p>Or: 1.3. Have a Higher National Diploma with a credit pass in a Biology related subject from an Institution recognized by the University senate,</p> <p>Or: 1.4. Have any other qualifications accepted by the University senate as equivalent to 1.1 to 1.4.</p>

(Offered in Mombasa Campus) 	<p>The common regulations for all masters' degree in the University shall apply.</p> <p>The general regulations of masters' degree in the School of Pure and Applied Sciences shall apply. The following shall be eligible for registration in the Master of Science in Applied Coastal & Marine Resource Management.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) A holder of a Bachelor of Science degree with at least an upper 2nd class honours with Zoology or Botany as a single subject or as one of the two (2) science subjects. b) A holder of a Bachelor of Education degree who has studied Zoology or Botany to degree level and has attained an upper 2nd class honour degree. c) A holder of a Bachelor degree in any other relevant areas of study such as Geography and Environment with at least an upper 2nd class honours degree and has taken units related to

Marine Science.

- d) A holder of Bachelors degree with a lower 2nd class may be accepted provided they can produce evidence of qualification in the relevant subjects.
